JOB DESCRIPTION

DESCRIPTION:

Atlas Campus Fellowship is seeking a full-time Campus Ministry Apprentice with an emphasis in Worship Ministry. The CMA is a 2-year apprenticeship experience designed to provide college graduates with on-the-ground ministry training through immersion and mentorship. The CMA is a central part of the leadership team at Atlas Campus Fellowship and Broadway Church of Christ. This is a full-time position with some funding provided and some support-raising required.

ABOUT ATLAS CAMPUS FELLOWSHIP:

Atlas Campus Fellowship is a Broadway Church of Christ ministry serving college-age students in the Lubbock, TX, area. It exists to journey alongside college students as they explore and develop a deeper faith and prepare for their next adventure in life.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Is a baptized believer willing to be an active member of the leadership team at Atlas and work under the oversight of the elders at the Broadway Church of Christ.
- Possesses a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited University.
- Demonstrates a desire to gain experience and practice in campus ministry and a willingness to make a 2-year commitment to the program.
- Possesses the ability to lead worship by themselves if required, but is also capable of empowering others.
- Demonstrates a willingness to commit at least 40 hours per week to the apprenticeship program, including participation in ministry activities, planning, and personal development.
- Demonstrates a willingness to fundraise a portion of his/her salary.



POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:


- **Leadership:** Contribute to the vision, planning, and implementation of all campus ministry activities and events.
- **Worship:** Ensure Atlas's worship is well organized and inspiring twice weekly (Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings) and at the Spring and Fall retreats.
 - Invest in the development of worship team members, empowering students to explore and utilize their musical gifts in service to the ministry.
 - Meet weekly with the worship team to practice with and encourage students on the worship team.
- **Administration:** Contribute to the details, setup, execution, cleanup, and follow-up of all campus ministry events and activities.
- **Community Life:** Cultivate and foster a deep sense of community among the students, investing significant time in building relationships with individuals, and helping form relationships between students.
- **Church Life:** The apprentice will be expected to attend all Broadway Church of Christ staff meetings and elders meetings. Additionally, the apprentice is expected to be an active and contributing member of the church, participating in Sunday morning services and developing personal relationships with church members.
- **Teaching:** The CMA will hone his/her teaching skills in various settings, including small groups, Bible classes, devotionals, and lessons. None of these opportunities are limited by gender within the college ministry.

COMPENSATION PACKAGE

- **Funding By Broadway:** The apprenticeship will be partially funded by Broadway Church of Christ, with the remainder fundraised by the apprentice.
 - Broadway Church of Christ will fund the apprentice \$1,000 monthly
- **Fundraising:** In campus ministry, and ministry in general fundraising is an increasingly important skill to develop to sustain the possibility of vocational ministry. Because of this, CMAs will be expected to raise support for a portion of their living expenses. Training will be provided *before* the apprenticeship begins. It is recommended that the apprentice fundraises an additional \$2000 a month. 100% of his/her necessary support should be funded before the apprenticeship begins.
