

Youth and Family Minister

The Livonia Church of Christ is beginning the search for a new youth and family minister. In June 2018, our preaching minister is retiring and our current youth minister will be filling the preaching position. Our hope is to have the new youth minister before then, starting around February to March 2018.

The minister's focus would be to oversee Fusion Student Ministry, which is comprised of around 12-15 students from grades 7-12.
