**Job Description:**

The associate minister's primary responsibility is to facilitate in the ongoing development, coordination, and execution of member involvement opportunities. These opportunities will be used in expanding greater ways for member outreach in the local community to include helping involve existing members new members and new converts into the work of the Lord at Mountain View Church of Christ.

Weekly duties: Assisting the pulpit minister with visitation of active members and members that are unable to attend services due to disabilities or other health conditions.

**Requirements:**
