Duties of Youth and Family Minister

- 1. Lead an effective youth program.
- 2. Lead youth on the pathway to salvation.
- 3. Inspire youth, their parents, and other young adults to do the Lord's work.
- 4. Teach teen classes.
- 5. Help organize and lead Vacation Bible School
- 6. Organize activities for K through 12th grade several times per year (some combined others age specific)
- 7. Initiate activities for young adults
- 8. Promote activities for families.
- 9. Encourage youth to attend Christian summer camps.
- 10. Planning and/or participating in mission trips for teens and/or adults.
- 11. Lead singing for the assembly as needed.
- 12. Lead singing for teens (teach them to sing and praise the Lord)
- 13. Communicate with families, young adults, teens and youth about events and activities.
- 14. Teach adult classes as needed (especially young adults)
- 15. Fill in as pulpit preacher as needed.
- 16. Assist with local outreach and evangelistic programs.
- 17. Build relationships with area ministers of -Youth and Family.
- 18. Inspire families, young married couples, singles, and youth to perfect their talents for the Lord.
- 19. The Youth and Family Minister is to:
 - a. Be sound and mature in the Faith.
 - b. Be friendly and outgoing.
 - c. Effectively communicate with the congregation.
 - d. Cooperate with the pulpit preacher.
 - e. Be responsible for Youth and Family items of weekly bulletin.
 - f. Cooperate with the deacon that works with youth.
 - g. Be in submission to the elders unless such submission is inconsistent with the scriptures.
 - h. Keep deacon for the youth and the elders informed of scheduled events.
 - i. Discuss trips and activities with deacon for youth and the elders prior to planning such events.
 - j. Conduct himself always as a Christian should, as his wife is also expected to conduct herself.
 - k. Wise and prudent use of the Lord's finances (Youth and Family Budget)
 - 1. Keep a log of activities and submit to the elders monthly.
