Williams Road is a church currently averaging 135 in attendance on Sunday mornings. We've experienced growth in past years and our youth group has played a major role in that growth.

Youth Group

We currently have 15 teens, grades 7 -12 on our roster. They are spread across the age spectrum, with the greatest number being 13-16.

Unique to a small town, we enjoy 2 National Historic Sites in the county (Jimmy Carter Museum in Plains and Andersonville on the other side of the county). In addition, Americus is the international headquarters for Habitat for Humanity.

For our intern, we provide a competitive salary of \$450 per week for 10 weeks, plus lodging, and utilities.
